

# Penny Black PROJECT GUIDE

**Penny Black Products Used:** 40-355 Crystal Frame, 1999L Letter Background

**Inchie Arts Products Used:** 1 ½ Inch White Art Squares

**Additional Products:** Imagine Crafts/Tsukineko: Tuxedo Black Memento, Blue Hawaii Stazon; Faber-Castell: Gel Medium; Liquitex: Clear Gesso; Ranger: Pearl Acrylic Paint Dabber; Sakura: Koi Watercolors; USArtQuest: Antique Bronze Metallic Watercolor; Other: White Tissue Paper

## Instructions:

Create a small box by gluing 5 - 1 ½" white Art Squares together. (The Art Square for the base will need to be trimmed slightly to compensate for the side squares overlapping.) Randomly stamp tissue paper with the snowflake (Crystal Frame) in Blue Hawaii Stazon and Letter Background in Tuxedo Black. Rip small sections from the tissue paper and adhere to the box with gel medium. Cover the entire box (excluding the lid). Let dry. Add watercolors and let dry. Paint box with clear gesso. Let dry and paint with Antique Bronze watercolor paint. To create the lid, glue two Art Squares together and punch a hole in the middle. Paint with pearl acrylic paint. Glue knob in place. Cut another Art Square slightly smaller (to fit the opening of the box) and glue to the bottom side of the lid.
