

# Penny Black PROJECT GUIDE

**Penny Black Products Used:** 30-134 Winter Magic, 51-066 Crystal Trio, 80-012 Wintertime Designer Paper Pad

**Additional Products:** Imagine Crafts/Tsukineko: VersaMark Watermark Ink, White Embossing Powder; Ranger: Waterfall Stickles; Scrapbook Adhesives: 3D Foam Squares; Other: White Pearls

## Instructions:

Create a  $3\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{3}{4}$  white card base. Cut a  $3\frac{1}{4} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$  piece of patterned paper from Wintertime and a  $1\frac{3}{8} \times 3\frac{1}{4}$  piece of white cardstock.

Edge one side of the rectangular piece of white cardstock with a strip of patterned paper.

Arrange all the papers on top of one another on the front flap of the card and die cut a circle. Separate the pieces and re-layer them using dimensional foam squares.

Cut a ring from patterned paper and stamp the sentiment in VersaMark Watermark ink and heat emboss with white powder. Align and attach to the front of the card.

Die cut the snowflake from white cardstock, color with variations of blue and purple then embellish with glitter glue.

Attach the snowflake in the center of the circular window to the inside back card flap. Embellish top and bottom left corners with pearls.
