

Penny Black PROJECT GUIDE

Penny Black Products Used: 40-590 aviary

Additional Products: hot pressed watercolor paper, versafine smokey gray ink, gansai tambi paints, Faber-Castell polychromos pencils

Instructions:

Stamp 'aviary' on hot pressed watercolor paper with versafine smokey gray ink.

Paint all the area surrounding the birdhouse and flowers with blue and green paint. Keep it loose and watery by painting some water first then adding some blue and some green paint. Let dry.

Paint the flower pots with brown paint; add shadows with the blue used for the background. Let dry.

Paint the bird house with the same brown. Add shadows once again with blue and a little black paint. Paint inside the birdhouse with diluted black.

Paint diluted pink in flowers on the right and diluted purple in flowers on left. Paint all leaves with same green as used in the background.

Paint birds with colors used already - black, purple, red.

Paint foreground with either dirty paint water or a diluted black. Add shadows with black.

When panel is dry, choose colored pencils that co-ordinate with the paint colors. Add darker details inside flowers with a purple and a deep pink pencil. Draw over the top of central flowers with purple pencil. Add yellow to central leaves.

Draw over wood in birdhouse with brown pencil, veins in leaves with green pencil and details on birds with black pencil.

Trim panel and attach to natural white card base.
