

Penny Black PROJECT GUIDE

Penny Black Products Used: 40-614 Exquisite, 40-470 Script 30-423 banner sentiments, 51-352 birds & banners

Additional Products: cold & hot pressed watercolor paper, chipped sapphire & seedless preserves distress stains, majestic blue versafine ink, dimensional tape

Instructions:

Place cold pressed watercolor paper in stamp positioner. Partially ink 'exquisite' stamp with seedless preserves distress stain. Stamp on panel then clean stamp.

Partially ink stamp again this time with chipped sapphire distress stain. Stamp and clean off stain. Repeat until whole image is stamped in a mix of the two stain colors.

Using a small watercolor brush blend the petals of each flower pulling ink from the stamped image to fill the space. Where color is pale, pick up some stain with brush and add it in. Clean brush when swapping from a blue flower to a pink flower. Let dry.

Pick up stain on paintbrush and paint the centers of the flowers to be darker than the petals. Paint stems with water blending the ink to fill them.

Add a few dots of water to area around flower. Partially ink 'script' stamp with chipped sapphire. Stamp off on scrap paper then stamp over dots of water for a pale watermarked background.

Repeat above step with seedless preserves stain.

Run seedless preserves distress stain dauber around the edge of the panel. Soften with a damp brush.

Die cut banner from hot pressed watercolor paper using die from 'birds & banners' set

Stamp sentiment from 'banner sentiments' in versafine majestic blue on die cut banner. Pop up with dimensional tape on flower panel.

Attach panel to natural white card base.
